HB 1436 -- CITY OF LIBERTY TRANSIENT GUEST TAX

SPONSOR: Neth

This bill authorizes the City of Liberty to impose, upon voter approval, a transient guest tax of not more than 6% per occupied room per night to be used solely for the purpose of promoting tourism, cultural activities, business, and economic development and for constructing related infrastructure and improvements.

The tax cannot be imposed if the City of Liberty or Clay County, in which the City of Liberty is located, already imposes a transient quest tax.
