HCS HB 1514 -- MARRIAGE LICENSES

SPONSOR: Rhoads

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass by Consent" by the Special Standing Committee on Corrections by a vote of 10 to 0.

This bill allows the county recorder of deeds to issue a marriage license to an applicant who is unable to sign the application in the presence of the recorder due to his or her incarceration if specified documents are submitted.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that this bill makes it so that a county recorder of deeds doesn't have to go to a correctional facility to issue a marriage license.

Testifying for the bill was Representative Rhoads.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
