

HB 1664 -- SOLAR ENERGY REBATES

SPONSOR: Berry

This bill allows an electrical utility to increase its retail costs by up to 1% to create new solar energy to fund solar rebates to customers producing solar power for the utility.

The bill revises the definition of "demand-side program" as it relates to the Missouri Energy Efficient Investment Act to include solar rebates that are authorized by the 1% increase in retail rates under these provisions to be consistent with existing demand side programs.
