

HB 1665 -- RELATED TO BOOKING PHOTOGRAPHS

SPONSOR: Jones (50)

This bill specifies that any person who publishes a person's arrest booking photograph on a website for purposes of commerce will be deemed to be transacting business in this state and requires that person to remove the photo from the website, without fee or compensation, within 30 days of a written request from the subject in the photograph. The request will include the subject individual's date of birth, date of arrest, and the name of the arresting law enforcement agency and will be transmitted via certified mail, return receipt requested, or statutory overnight delivery, to the registered agent, principal place of business, or primary residence of the person who published the website.
