

HB 1883 -- COMMITTEES AND COMMISSIONS

SPONSOR: Flanigan

This bill modifies and repeals various provisions of law regarding committees and commissions.

The bill:

(1) Removes the exemption for unexpended balance transfers to the General Revenue Fund from the Statutory Revision Fund administered by the Joint Committee on Legislative Research;

(2) Eliminates the daily per diem for members of the Seismic Safety Commission and places an expiration date on the commission and its activities on December 31, 2014;

(3) Modifies the basis for the actuarial analysis of the cost impact to private and public payers of any new or revised mandated health care benefit to be reviewed by the Oversight Division within the Joint Committee on Legislative Research from proposed legislation to enacted legislation. The review must be delivered to the General Assembly prior to July 1 of the year following the year in which the mandate is enacted. The provisions for the report of the oral administered anticancer medication mandate and the eating disorder mandate which expired on December 31, 2013, is repealed;

(4) Repeals the provisions regarding the Joint Committee on Corrections; and

(5) Repeals the provisions regarding the Commission on Special Health, Psychological and Social Needs of Minority Individuals.
