

HB 2169 -- STATE PROCUREMENT

SPONSOR: Parkinson

This bill changes the laws regarding state procurement. The bill increases the amount for state purchases made by competitive bid from \$3,000 to \$10,000 and for solicited bids from \$25,000 to \$100,000.

The bill also authorizes the Commissioner of Administration to hold reverse auctions to procure merchandise, supplies, raw materials, or finished goods if price is the primary factor in evaluating bids.
