HB 2263 -- HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

SPONSOR: Sommer

This bill requires all House bills and joint resolutions filed in the first regular session of a General Assembly that have not been truly agreed to and finally passed or defeated in a House committee or on the floor of the House to be carried over and stand filed in the second regular session in its last form on the last day of the session. Bills and joint resolutions must be first and second read in the House and referred to the same or like committee as it was in the first regular session. The committee is not required to have a public hearing if a hearing was held in the first regular session but the bill or resolution must be taken up for consideration and passed before it advances from the committee. The House of Representatives may adopt rules for the administration of these provisions.
