HB 2300 -- LEGISLATIVE STAFF COMPENSATION FOR ELECTION CAMPAIGNS

SPONSOR: Gatschenberger

This bill prohibits any staff member for a member of the General Assembly from receiving compensation for any services rendered as a part of a campaign for a candidate for public or statewide office or for the passage or defeat of a ballot measure. "Staff member" means anyone employed as a legislative assistant, chief of staff, legislative director, or any paid position reporting to or taking direction from a member of the General Assembly.
