HJR 63 -- GENERAL ASSEMBLY TERM LIMITS

SPONSOR: Lichtenegger

Upon voter approval, this proposed constitutional amendment, beginning with the 2016 general election, changes the members of the House of Representatives elected term from two years to four years and changes the term limitations for members of the General Assembly from the current eight year limitations for service in the House or Senate, or four terms of two years in the House and two terms of four years in the Senate, to three terms of four years each in either the House or the Senate. The total allowable years of service in the General Assembly will change from 16 years to 24 years.
