

HJR 91 -- SALES AND USE TAX INCREASE FOR EDUCATION

SPONSOR: Korman

Upon voter approval, this proposed constitutional amendment increases the state sales and use tax by .25% beginning January 1, 2015, to provide additional moneys for primary and secondary education in the form of funds for infrastructure development, equipment purchases, and bond payments. The additional tax revenue must be distributed in the same ratio that the weighted average daily attendance in the district bears to the total weighted average daily attendance in all school districts for the preceding year.
