1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 63, Section A, Page 1, Line 2, by inserting
2 after all of said Section and Line the following:

4 "115.190. 1. No person shall qualify as a candidate for elective public office in the state of Missouri
5 who has been found guilty of or pled guilty to a felony or misdemeanor under the federal laws of the
6 United States of America or to a felony under the laws of this state.

7 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, no person shall be appointed
8 to any public office if the person is delinquent in the payment of any state income taxes, personal
9 property taxes, real property taxes on the place of residence, or any county or municipal taxes or user
10 fees."; and

12 Further amend said bill, Page 1, Section 115.305, Line 2, by inserting after all of said Section and
13 Line the following:

15 "[115.348. No person shall qualify as a candidate for elective public office in the state of
16 Missouri who has been found guilty of or pled guilty to a felony or misdemeanor under the federal
17 laws of the United States of America.]

19 [115.350. No person shall qualify as a candidate for elective public office in the state of
20 Missouri who has been convicted of or found guilty of or pled guilty to a felony under the laws of
21 this state.]; and

23 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
24 accordingly.
