	purpose so long as any infrastructure and building built or improved is in the development area. The
_	port authority board of commissioners shall file an annual report indicating the established AIM
	zones with the department of revenue;
-	(2) "New job", the number of full-time employees located at the project facility that exceeds
1	the project facility base employment less any decrease in the number of full-time employees at
	related facilities below the related facility base employment. No job that was created prior to the
	late of the notice of intent shall be deemed a new job. An employee that spends less than fifty
	percent of the employee's work time at the facility is still considered to be located at a facility if the
_	mployee receives his or her directions and control from that facility, is on the facility's payroll, one
	undred percent of the employee's income from such employment is Missouri income, and the
	employee is paid at or above the state average wage.
	3. Any port authority located in this state may establish an AIM zone. Such zone may only
į	nclude the area within the port authority's jurisdiction and may include any such area. The port
2	authority shall determine the boundaries for each AIM zone, and more than one AIM zone may exist

- 1 shall consist of money collected under this section. The state treasurer shall be custodian of the fund 2 and shall approve disbursements from the fund in accordance with sections 30.170 and 30.180 to the 3 port authorities from which the funds were collected, less the pro-rata portion appropriated by the 4 general assembly to be used solely for the administration of this section which shall not exceed ten 5 percent of the total amount collected within the zones of a port authority. Notwithstanding the 6 provisions of section 33.080 to the contrary, any moneys remaining in the fund at the end of the 7 biennium shall not revert to the credit of the general revenue fund. The state treasurer shall invest 8 moneys in the fund in the same manner as other funds are invested. Any interest and moneys earned 9 on such investments shall be credited to the fund.

No debts may be incurred or reauthorized using AIM zone revenue after August 28, 2035."; and
