1 AMEND House Bill No. 473, Page 1, In the Title, Lines 2-3, by deleting the words "county
2 municipal courts" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "municipal government"; and
3

4 Further amend said bill, Page 2, Section 67.320, Line 31, by inserting after all of said section and
5 line the following:

7 "79.120. The mayor shall have a seat in and preside over the board of aldermen, and shall be
8 counted for purposes of establishing a quorum, but shall not vote on any question except in case of a
9 tie, nor shall he or she preside or vote in cases when he or she is an interested party. If a quorum is
10 present and one-half of the members elected or appointed to the board of aldermen have voted in
11 favor of the question, the vote shall be deemed a tie. If the mayor votes in accordance with one-half
12 of the members of the board of aldermen to break a tie as authorized in this section, the resulting
13 action shall be deemed the action of a majority of the board of aldermen. [He] The mayor shall
14 exercise a general supervision over all the officers and affairs of the city subject to the direction of
15 the board of aldermen, and shall take care that the ordinances of the city, and the state laws relating
16 to such city, are complied with."; and

18 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
19 accordingly.
