inserting after all of said line the following:

4 "94.360. 1. The council of any incorporated town or city 5 in this state having a special charter and which contains not 6 more than thirty thousand inhabitants may by ordinance levy and 7 collect a license tax on wholesale houses, auctioneers, 8 architects, druggists, grocers, banks, brokers, wholesale 9 merchants, merchants of all kinds, confectioners, delivery 10 trucks, ice trucks, transfer trucks, laundry wagons, milk wagons, 11 merchant delivery companies, cigar and tobacco stands, hay 12 scales, wood dealers, coal dealers, coal distributors, coal 13 truckers, lumber dealers, real estate agents, loan companies, abstracters, abstract agencies, loan agents, collection agencies, 14 15 undertakers, public buildings, office buildings, public halls, 16 public grounds, concerts, photographers in office or upon 17 streets, canvassers, artists, drummers, patent right dealers, 18 insurance companies, insurance agents, taverns, hotels, rooming 19 houses, boarding houses, sanitariums, hospitals, health schools, 20 telephone companies, street contractors, paperhanger contractors, 21 painting contractors, plastering contractors, and all 22 subcontractors, flour mills, express company agencies, opticians, wagons, buggies, carriages, tinners, barbers, barbershops, 23 24 hairdressers, hair dressing shops, whether conducted in 25 connection with other business or separate, beauty parlors, 26 tailors, florists, nursery stock agents, bookbinders, monument 27 dealers, and agencies, manufacturing agents, shoe cobbler shops,

storage warehouses, shoe shining parlors, job printing plants, 1 2 outdoor advertising, ready-to-wear clothing agencies, tailor-made clothing agencies, sewing machine agencies, piano and organ 3 4 dealers and agents, foreign coffee and tea dealers, and agents or 5 all other vocations whatsoever, and fix the rate of carriage of 6 persons and wagonage, drayage and cartage of property; and may 7 levy and collect a license tax and regulate hawkers, peddlers, pawnbrokers, restaurants, butchers, wholesale butchers, 8 9 bathhouses and masseurs, lunch stands, lunch counters, lunch 10 wagons, soft drink and ice cream stands and vendors, ice cream 11 parlors, peanut and popcorn stands, and stands of every kind, 12 hucksters, opera houses, moving picture shows, private parks, 13 public lectures, public meetings, baseball parks, horse and cattle dealers, stockyards, wagon yards, auto yards, oil 14 15 stations, wholesale and retail inspectors, gaugers, mercantile 16 agents, manufacturing and other corporations, or institutions, 17 machine shops, blacksmith shops, radio repair shops, foundries, 18 sewer contractors, building contractors, stone contractors, 19 sidewalk contractors, bridge contractors, plumbing contractors, 20 brick contractors, cement contractors, and all subcontractors, 21 street railroad cars, gas companies, light companies, power 22 companies, and water companies, laundries, laundry agencies, rug 23 and carpet cleaners, linen supply rental service, conditioning 24 and renting for use, bed linen, table linen, towels, rugs, 25 uniform aprons, coats, caps, coveralls, chair covers, automobile seat covers or any other items, ice plants and ice plant 26 27 agencies, ice dealers, omnibuses, automobiles, automobile 28 trailers, tractors, carts, drays, milk wagons, laundry wagons, 29 delivery wagons, transfer and job wagons, ice wagons, and all 30 other vehicles, traveling and auction stores, plumbers, pressing 31 establishments, installment houses and agencies, produce and 32 poultry dealers, feather renovators, baker and bakeries, bakery 33 delivery wagons, and delivery autos, bottling works, dye works, cleaning establishments, sand plants, steamfitters, corn doctors, 34 35 chiropodists, hackmen, taxicabs, buses, draymen, omnibus drivers, 36 porters, dairies, and regulate the same, and all other pursuing 37 like occupations; and may levy and collect a license tax,

regulate, restrain, prohibit and suppress ordinaries, money 1 2 brokers, money changers, intelligence and employment offices, and 3 agencies, public masquerades, balls, street exhibitions, dance 4 halls, fortune tellers, pistol galleries, shooting galleries, 5 palmists, private venereal hospitals, museums, menageries, 6 equestrian performances, fluoroscopic views, picture shows, 7 telescopic views, lung testers, muscle developers, magnifying 8 glasses, ten pin alleys, ball alleys, bowling alleys, billiard 9 tables, pool and other tables, miniature golf courses, theatrical 10 or other exhibitions, boxing and sparring exhibitions, shows and 11 amusements, amusement parks, and the sale of unclaimed goods by 12 express companies or common carriers, auto wrecking shops, bill 13 posters, junk dealers, porters, carnival and street fairs, circuses and shows for parade and exhibition, or both, skating 14 15 rinks and runners, and solicitors for steamboats, cars, stages, 16 taxicabs, hotels, rooming houses, boarding houses, bathhouses, 17 masseurs, hospitals, sanitariums, health schools, and all other 18 pursuing like occupations.

19 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the 20 contrary, the total license taxes, including those authorized 21 under section 94.270 and this section, imposed upon hotels or 22 motels levied by any city shall not exceed one-eighth of one 23 percent of a hotel's or motel's gross revenue or the tax rate 24 imposed on hotels and motels as of May 1, 2015, whichever is 25 higher. The provisions of this subsection shall not apply to any tax levied in compliance with subsection 7 of section 94.270."; 26 27 and
