1 AMEND House Bill No. 430, Page 2, Section 37.071, Line 51, by inserting after all of said section  
2 and line the following:

4 "67.2730. 1. Every county and municipality shall establish and operate its own government  
5 website or webpage available to members of the public. The website or webpage established under  
6 this section may be operated on the county or municipality's own domain or on another entity's  
7 domain, including, but not limited to, social networks available to the general public.

8 2. Every county and municipality shall update its government website or webpage established  
9 under this section each month.

10 3. Every county and municipality shall include all of the following items on its government  
11 website or webpage established under this section:

12 (1) Information on its elected officials and governmental staff, including the date of the end  
13 of the term for each elected official and the name, title, and contact information for each elected  
14 official and governmental staff member;

15 (2) The name, title, and official contact information for its custodian of records;

16 (3) Hours of operation for its offices;

17 (4) If operating a court, the hours of operation for the court and the names of any judge, city  
18 attorney, and prosecutor;

19 (5) The time and location of its next board or council meeting.

20 (6) In addition to other notification requirements under section 610.020, the county or  
21 municipality shall announce all public meetings on its website or webpage at least twenty-four hours  
22 prior to any meeting, and shall include the meeting agenda;

23 (7) The contact information for the police and fire departments;

24 (8) Each county and municipality which hosts its own website shall include on its website:

25 (a) The most recent financial report;

26 (b) All ordinances, codes, and regulations currently in effect;

27 (c) The most recently adopted budget; and

28 (d) An archive that provides access to all agendas and meeting minutes; and

29 (9) Each county and municipality choosing to comply with this section by the creation of a  
30 webpage on a social network or other third-party host which does not allow the uploading of  
31 documents shall provide the items described in subdivision (7) within forty-eight hours in digital  
32 format and at no charge to any person who requests them through the custodian of records listed on  
33 the webpage. In lieu of including the items described in subdivision (7) on the webpage, the county  
34 or municipality shall include a statement on the webpage informing visitors that the items described  
35 in subdivision (7) are available in digital format at no charge through a request to the custodian of  
36 records.

1 4. Every county and municipality shall file the domain address of its government website or webpage  
2 with the office of administration, which shall host a webpage available to the public that provides a  
3 list of all official local government websites and webpages established under this section.

4 5. The provisions of this section are prospective only. No county or municipality shall be required to  
5 publish on a website or webpage or provide within twenty-four hours of request under subdivision  
6 (8) of subsection 3 of this section a digital archive to agendas and meeting minutes prior to the  
7 effective date of this section."; and

9 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
10 accordingly.  
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
