1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 456,
2 Page 1, Line 3 of the Title, by deleting the words "ownership of"; and

4 Further amend said bill, Page 17, Section 301.562, Line 145, by inserting after said line the
5 following:

7 "306.126. 1. [The operator of a motorboat shall not allow any person to ride or sit on the
8 gunwales, decking over the bow, railing, top of seat back or decking over the back of the motorboat
9 while under way, unless such person is inboard of adequate guards or railing provided on the
10 motorboat to prevent a passenger from being lost overboard. As used in this section, the term
11 "adequate guards or railing" means guards or railings having a height parameter of at least six inches
12 but not more than eighteen inches. Nothing in this section shall be construed to mean that passengers
13 or other persons aboard a motorboat cannot occupy the decking over the bow of the boat to moor it
14 to a mooring buoy or to cast off from such a buoy, or for any other necessary purpose. The
15 provisions of this section shall not apply to vessels propelled by sail.

16 2.] Whenever any person leaves any watercraft, other than a personal watercraft, on the
17 waters of the Mississippi River, the waters of the Missouri River or the lakes of this state and enters
18 the water between the hours of 11:00 a.m. and sunset, the operator of such watercraft shall display on
19 the watercraft a red or orange flag measuring not less than twelve inches by twelve inches. The
20 provisions of this subsection shall not apply to watercraft that is moored or anchored. The flag
21 required by this subsection shall be visible for three hundred sixty degrees around the horizon when
22 displayed and shall be displayed only when an occupant of the watercraft has left the confines of the
23 watercraft and entered the water. The flag required by this subsection shall not be displayed when
24 the watercraft is engaged in towing any person, but shall be displayed when such person has ceased
25 being towed and has reentered the water.

26 [3.] 2. No operator shall knowingly operate any watercraft within fifty yards of a flag
27 required by subsection 2 of this section at a speed in excess of a slow-no wake speed."; and

29 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
