1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 456,  
2 Page 17, Section 301.644, Line 145, by inserting immediately after said line the following:

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4 "304.855. No county, city, town, village, municipality, state agency, or other political  
5 subdivision of this state shall enact, adopt, or enforce any law, ordinance, regulation, order, or other  
6 provision that authorizes the use of an automated traffic enforcement system or systems to establish  
7 evidence that a motor vehicle or its operator is not in compliance with traffic signals, traffic speeds,  
8 or other traffic laws, ordinances, rules, or regulations on any public street, road or highway within  
9 this state, or to impose or collect any civil or criminal fine, fee, or penalty for any such  
10 noncompliance. Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit or limit the otherwise lawful  
11 use of automated license plate readers."; and  
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13 Further amend said bill, Page 19, Section 407.581, Line 95, by inserting immediately after said line  
14 the following:  
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16 "Section B. Section A of this act is hereby submitted to the qualified voters of this state for  
17 approval or rejection at an election which is hereby ordered and which shall be held and conducted  
18 on the Tuesday immediately following the first Monday in August, 2016, or at a special election to  
19 be called by the governor for that purpose, pursuant to the laws and constitutional provisions of this  
20 state applicable to general elections and the submission of referendum measures by initiative  
21 petition, and it shall become effective when approved by a majority of the votes cast thereon at such  
22 election and not otherwise.

23 Section C. Under chapter 116, RSMo, and other applicable constitutional provisions and  
24 laws of this state allowing the general assembly to adopt ballot language for the submission of this  
25 act to the voters of this state, the official ballot title of this act shall be as follows:

26 "Shall Missouri law be amended to: Prohibit political subdivisions and state agencies from  
27 using automated traffic enforcement systems to establish evidence of noncompliance with traffic  
28 signals, speeds, or other laws or ordinances on public streets, roads or highways within this state, or  
29 to impose or collect fines, fees, or penalties for noncompliance?"; and  
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31 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
32 accordingly.
