1 AMEND Senate Bill No. 272, Page 1, in the Title, Line 3, by deleting "municipal commercial zones"  
2 and inserting in lieu thereof "political subdivisions"; and

4 Further amend said bill and page, Section A, Line 2, by inserting the following after all of said line:

6 "79.120. The mayor shall have a seat in and preside over the board of aldermen, and shall be  
7 counted for purposes of establishing a quorum, but shall not vote on any question except in case of a  
8 tie, nor shall he or she preside or vote in cases when he or she is an interested party. If a quorum is  
9 present and one-half of the members elected or appointed to the board of aldermen have voted in  
10 favor of the question, the vote shall be deemed a tie. If the mayor votes in accordance with one-half  
11 of the members of the board of aldermen to break a tie as authorized in this section, the resulting  
12 action shall be deemed the action of a majority of the board of aldermen. [He] The mayor shall  
13 exercise a general supervision over all the officers and affairs of the city subject to the direction of  
14 the board of aldermen, and shall take care that the ordinances of the city, and the state laws relating  
15 to such city, are complied with."; and

17 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
18 accordingly.
