1 AMEND House Bill No. 476, Page 1, Section 163.045, Lines 1-14, by deleting all of said section
2 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4 "163.045. 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 2 of section 163.031 to the
5 contrary, in any school year in which a school district's average daily attendance increases from three
6 hundred fifty or less to more than three hundred fifty or decreases from more than three hundred
7 fifty to three hundred fifty or less, such school district shall receive state aid as calculated under
8 section 163.031 based on the school district's average daily attendance in the school year
9 immediately preceding such increase or decrease. Such school district shall continue to receive state
10 aid based on the school district's immediately preceding average daily attendance in the previous
11 school year until any such increase or decrease in average daily attendance is maintained by the
12 school district for two consecutive school years. If an increase or decrease in average daily
13 attendance is maintained for two consecutive school years by the school district, the school district
14 shall receive state aid as calculated under section 163.031 based on the average daily attendance
15 maintained for the previous two school years."; and

17 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
18 accordingly.
