1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 270,  
2 Page 1, In the title, Line 4, by deleting the words, "retirement systems" and inserting in lieu the  
3 word, "employees"; and

5 Further amend said bill, Page 13, Section 86.320, Line 22, by inserting after all of said line the  
6 following:

7 "167.045. 1. Except as provided in subsection 4 of this section, a public school that  
8 participates in an activity sponsored by the Missouri State High School Activities Association  
9 (MSHSAA) shall provide a student that attends a home school, as defined in section 167.031, who  
10 resides in the public school's attendance area with the opportunity to participate in the activity on  
11 behalf of the public school in the same manner that the public school provides the opportunity to  
12 participate to students enrolled in the public school.

13 2. A home school student who seeks to participate or who participates in a MSHSAA  
14 activity on behalf of a public school is subject to the relevant policies that apply to students enrolled  
15 in the public school, including policies regarding registration, age eligibility, fees, insurance,  
16 transportation, physical condition, qualifications, responsibilities, event schedules, standards of  
17 behavior, and performance.

18 3. As a condition of participation by a home school student in a MSHSAA activity under this  
19 section, the individual who primarily provides instruction to the student shall submit a written  
20 verification to the public school indicating whether the student is:

21 (1) Receiving a passing grade in each course or subject taught; and

22 (2) Maintaining satisfactory progress towards academic advancement or promotion.

23 4. A home school student is not authorized by this section to participate in a MSHSAA  
24 activity during the remainder of any school year during which the student was previously enrolled in  
25 a public school.

26 5. The MSHSAA may not prohibit a home school student from participating in activities in  
27 the manner authorized by this section."; and

29 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
30 accordingly.
