1 AMEND House Bill No. 556, Page 1, in the Title, Line 3, by deleting all of said line and inserting in  
2 lieu thereof the words "relating to juvenile courts."; and

4 Further amend said bill, Page 5, Section 211.036, Line 28, by inserting immediately after all of said  
5 line and section the following:

7 "211.067. Notwithstanding any provision of law, in lieu of being detained or fined for a  
8 misdemeanor violation, violating an ordinance, or as a condition of probation, the juvenile court  
9 shall consider ordering the juvenile to attend school. If the juvenile obtains two unexcused absences,  
10 the juvenile may then be detained or fined, as determined by the juvenile court."; and

12 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
13 accordingly.
