1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for  
2 Senate Bill No. 278, Page 33, Section 301.645, Line 17, by inserting immediately after said line the  
3 following:

5 "304.288. 1. Beginning August 28, 2015, no county, city, town, village, municipality, state  
6 agency, or other political subdivision of this state may enact, adopt, or enforce any law, ordinance,  
7 regulation, order, or other provision that authorizes the use of an automated traffic enforcement  
8 system or systems, including automatic number plate recognition systems, to establish evidence that  
9 a motor vehicle or its operator is not in compliance with traffic signals, traffic speeds, or other traffic  
10 laws, ordinances, rules, or regulations on any public street, road, or highway within this state or to  
11 impose or collect any civil or criminal fine, fee, or penalty for any such noncompliance, except as  
12 permitted under subsection 2 of this section.

13 2. Any county, city, town, village, municipality, state agency, or other political subdivision  
14 of this state that has an automated traffic enforcement system installation or maintenance contract  
15 with a company or entity on August 28, 2015, shall arrange to complete or terminate the contract by  
16 September 1, 2016. The provisions of subsection 1 of this section shall apply to the county, city,  
17 town, village, municipality, state agency, or other political subdivision after the termination or  
18 completion of such installation or maintenance contracts.

19 3. As used in this section, the following terms shall mean:

20 (1) "Automated traffic enforcement system", a camera or optical device designed to record  
21 images that depict the motor vehicle, the motor vehicle operator, the license plate of the motor  
22 vehicle, or other images to establish evidence that the motor vehicle or its operator is not in  
23 compliance with state law, ordinance, order, or other provision;

24 (2) "Automatic number plate recognition systems", a mass surveillance method that uses  
25 optical character recognition on images to read vehicle license plates."; and

27 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
