employer in addition to wages and salary. The term includes, but is not limited to, health, disability,		
retirement, profit-sharing, and death benefits; group accidental death and dismemberment benefits;		
paid or unpaid days off from work for holidays, sick leave, vacation, and personal necessity; and		
terms of employment, attendance, or leave policies;		
(4) "Political subdivision", any county, city, town, or village.		
2. No political subdivision shall establish, mandate, or otherwise require an employer to		
provide to an employee:		
(1) A minimum or living wage rate; or		
(2) Employment benefits;		
that exceed the requirements of federal or state laws, rules, or regulations.		
3. No political subdivision shall prohibit an employer from inquiring into or considering an		
applicant for employment's criminal history on an initial employment application.		
4. The state auditor, when auditing political subdivisions, shall have the authority to verify		
that the political subdivision is complying with the provisions of this section."; and		
Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references accordingly.
