| 4 | "306.126. 1. [The operator of a motorboat shall not allow any person to ride or sit on the |
| 5 | gunwales, decking over the bow, railing, top of seat back or decking over the back of the motorboat |
| 6 | while under way, unless such person is inboard of adequate guards or railing provided on the |
| 7 | motorboat to prevent a passenger from being lost overboard. As used in this section, the term |
| 8 | "adequate guards or railing" means guards or railings having a height parameter of at least six inches |
| 9 | but not more than eighteen inches. Nothing in this section shall be construed to mean that passengers |
| 10 | or other persons aboard a motorboat cannot occupy the decking over the bow of the boat to moor it |
| 11 | to a mooring buoy or to cast off from such a buoy, or for any other necessary purpose. The |

| 18 | required by this subsection shall be visible for three hundred sixty degrees around the horizon when |
| 19 | displayed and shall be displayed only when an occupant of the watercraft has left the confines of the |
| 20 | watercraft and entered the water. The flag required by this subsection shall not be displayed when |
| 21 | the watercraft is engaged in towing any person, but shall be displayed when such person has ceased |
| 22 | being towed and has reentered the water. |
