Bill Summary: This proposal changes the laws regarding tort liability associated with the

concealed carry of firearms.

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** and the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies. Officials from the **Attorney General's Office** assume that any potential costs arising from the proposal could be absorbed with existing resources.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
