FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Missouri Department of Conservation (MDC)** estimates the proposed legislation would have a negative fiscal impact of less than \$100,000 annually on their organization.

Oversight assumes MDC is provided with core funding to handle a certain amount of activity each year. Oversight assumes MDC could absorb the costs related to this proposal.

Officials from the **Attorney General's Office** assume any potential cost arising from this proposal can be absorbed with existing resources.

Officials from the Department of Agriculture, Department of Economic Development, Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, Department of Higher Education, Department of Health and Senior Services, Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration, Department of Mental Health, Department of Natural Resources, Department of Corrections, Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, Department of Revenue, Department of Public Safety (Office of the Director, Capitol Police, Gaming Commission, Missouri Highway Patrol, State Emergency Management Agency and the Veterans Commission) Department of Social Services, Office of the Governor, Joint Committee on Public Employee Retirement, Missouri Lottery Commission, Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan, Missouri Ethics Commission, Office of Prosecution Services, MoDOT & Patrol Employees' Retirement System, Office of Administration (Administrative Hearing Commission and Budget and Planning), Office of the State Courts Administrator, Office of the State Auditor, Office of the Secretary of State and the Office of the State Treasurer each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

In response to a previous version, officials from the Department of Public Safety - Missouri National Guard and the Division of Fire Safety, the Missouri House of Representatives, the Office of the Lieutenant Governor, the Department of Transportation, the Missouri State Employee's Retirement System, the Missouri Senate the Office of the State Public Defender and the State Tax Commission each assumed the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Oversight assumes the amendment will have no fiscal impact on State or Local Governments.
