Bill Summary: This proposal specifies that early elective deliveries without a medical

necessity shall not be reimbursed by MO HealthNet.

State Fiscal Highlights

• No direct fiscal impact on the state is anticipated.

Local Fiscal Highlights

• No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the **Department of Social Services**, **MoHealthNet Division (MHD)** and **Division of Legal Services** state this proposal will not result in a savings to the state as the MHD currently has a policy in place stating that Early Elective Deliveries (EEDs) are not reimbursable under the MO HealthNet program.

Officials from the **Department of Health and Senior Services** assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their agency.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
