FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Oversight was unable to receive some of the agency responses in a timely manner due to the short fiscal note request time. Oversight has presented this fiscal note on the best current information that we have or on prior year information regarding a similar bill. Upon the receipt of agency responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval of the chairperson of the Joint Committee on Legislative Research to publish a new fiscal note.

Officials from the **Department of Revenue (DOR)** assume procedures will need to be revised by a Management Analyst Specialist I requiring 40 hours at a cost of \$890 in FY 2016. DOR also assumes the Titling Manual will need to be revised. This will require 40 hours for a Management Analyst Specialist I, at a cost of \$890 in FY 2016.

Oversight assumes DOR is provided with core funding to handle a certain amount of activity each year. Oversight assumes DOR could absorb the costs related to this proposal. If multiple bills pass which require additional staffing and duties at substantial costs, DOR could request funding through the appropriation process.

In response to a similar proposal (HB 1118) from 2014, officials from the **Department of Public Safety** - **Missouri Highway Patrol** assumed the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Officials from the **Department of Insurance**, **Financial Institutions and Professional Registration** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.
