### Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan, the Department of Corrections, the Missouri Department of Conservation, the Department of Mental Health, the Department of Health and Senior Services, and the Department of Social Services each assume the current proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Officials from the **Office of Administration** defer to Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan for fiscal impact.

In response to a previous version, officials from the **Department of Insurance**, **Financial Institutions and Professional Registration** assumed the bill would not create a fiscal impact.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
