Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the Office of the Governor, the Office of Administration, the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, the Department of Economic Development, the Missouri Veterans Commission, the Department of Social Services, and the Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration assume the current proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Oversight assumes that because this proposal only removes obsolete, expire, sunset and terminated statutory sections, it will not have a fiscal impact on state or local government.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
