#### **FISCAL ANALYSIS**

#### **ASSUMPTION**

#### § 644.145 - Clean Water Law:

Officials from the **Department of Natural Resources (DNR)** assume this proposal would add public water or sewer treatment works to the types of facilities DNR would be required to make finding of affordability determinations when issuing permits that incorporate a new requirement for discharges.

DNR assumes this proposal relates to publicly owned water and sewer facilities permitted to discharge and therefore would anticipate minimal fiscal impact.

**Oversight** assumes this proposal will have no direct fiscal impact on state or local government funds.

Officials from the **Department of Health and Senior Services**, **Department of Economic Development-Division of Energy**, and the **Missouri Public Service Commission** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Officials from the Cole County Public Water District #4, Franklin County Water District, Cole County Public Water District #3, and the St. Charles County Public Water Supply District #2 did not respond to Oversight's request for fiscal impact.
