ASSUMPTION

Upon the receipt of agency responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval of the chairperson of the Joint Committee on Legislative Research to publish a new fiscal note.

Officials from the **Office of the State Auditor** state they are not statutorily authorized to audit associations, therefore the language set forth in this legislation will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Officials from the **Office of Administration** stated the proposal would have no direct fiscal impact on their organization.

Officials from the **Special School District** and the **Maltabend Public School District** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.
