**Bill Summary:** This proposal establishes procedures to allow territories in certain sewer districts to detach from the districts and procedures for the dissolution of special purpose districts.

State Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on the state is anticipated.

Local Fiscal Highlights

- No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.

Fiscal Analysis

**Oversight** was unable to receive some of the agency responses in a timely manner due to the short fiscal note request time. Oversight has presented this fiscal note on the best current information that we have or on prior year information regarding a similar bill. Upon the receipt of agency responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval of the chairperson of the Joint Committee on Legislative Research to publish a new fiscal note.

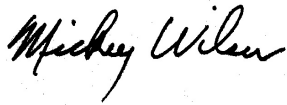
Officials at the **Platte County Board of Election Commission** assume the cost of holding an election for a district for one question is about \$6,500. This cost could decrease if other entities are participating in the election.

**Oversight** assumes local political subdivisions would place these issue on the ballot on a regularly scheduled election date. Therefore, Oversight assumes no additional costs to locals.

Officials at the **Office of the Secretary of State**, the **Department of Natural Resources** and the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** each assume no fiscal impact to their respective agencies from this proposal.

FISCAL ANALYSIS (continued)

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
