Bill Summary: This proposal provides that a degree in a program accredited by the Psychological Clinical Science Accreditation System meets various psychologist licensure requirements.

Local Fiscal Highlights


- No direct fiscal impact on local political subdivisions is anticipated.

Fiscal Analysis

In response to a similar proposal, SB 368, officials from the **Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration** assumed the proposal would not fiscally impact their agency.

Officials from the **Department of Higher Education**, the **Missouri State University**, the **Kansas City Metropolitan Community College**, and the **State Technical College of Missouri** each assume the current proposal would not fiscally impact their respective organizations.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal. Also, this legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
