#### FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials at the Department of Higher Education, Kansas City Public Schools, Missouri State University, Special School District of St. Louis, St. Louis Community College and the University of Central Missouri each assume there is no fiscal impact to their respective organization from this proposal.

Officials at the **Metropolitan Community College** (MCC) assume the potential financial impact with the proposed legislation would be that by broadening the definition of eligible schools allowed to cooperate with public high schools, MCC may see a decrease in the number of dual credit students taking advantage of MCC courses (if they can now get dual credit from a two-year technical/vocational school, etc.). The impact might not be significant but can't be determined at this time.

Officials at the **State Technical College of Missouri** assume this would have a positive impact on the school. The exact impact can not be determined at this time.

**Oversight** assumes this proposal would not impact a college unless the college chooses to enter into an agreement with a public high school. Oversight will show no direct fiscal impact from this proposal.
