AN ACT

To repeal section 478.740, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the 38^{th} judicial circuit.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 478.740, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 478.740, to read as follows:

478.740. 1. There shall be two circuit judges in the thirty-eighth judicial circuit. These judges shall sit in divisions numbered one and two.

- 2. The circuit judge in division two shall be a resident of Taney county and shall be
- 4 elected by the residents of that county in 2016, and such judicial position shall not be
- 5 considered vacant or filled until January 1, 2017. The judge in division one shall be a resident
- 6 of Christian county and shall be elected by the residents of that county in 2018.
