JOINT RESOLUTION

Submitting to the qualified voters of Missouri an amendment to article IV of the Constitution of Missouri, and adopting one new section in lieu thereof relating to spending transportation funds coming from state revenue.

Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring therein:

That at the next general election to be held in the state of Missouri, on Tuesday next
2 following the first Monday in November, 2016, or at a special election to be called by the
3 governor for that purpose, there is hereby submitted to the qualified voters of this state, for
4 adoption or rejection, the following amendment to article IV of the Constitution of the state of
5 Missouri:

Section A. Article IV, Constitution of Missouri, is amended and one new section adopted
2 in lieu thereof, to be known as section 30(f) to read as follows:

**Section 30(f). 1. No tax credit shall be authorized or issued for any fiscal year
2 following a fiscal year in which the department of transportation failed to obligate the total
3 federal highway aid for road and bridge construction and maintenance.**
4 **2. A commission comprised of five members shall evaluate the funding status of the
5 department in order to determine if the department has met the funding level required
6 under subsection 1 of this section. Beginning on January 1, 2017, the five members shall
7 be appointed to two-year terms by the president pro tem and minority leader of the senate,
8 the speaker and minority leader of the house of representatives, and the governor and shall
9 be eligible for reappointment. The commission shall file a report with the general assembly
10 by December 31, 2019, and every two years thereafter and shall meet as often as necessary
11 to perform the duties required under this section.**

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EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.
