### AN ACT

To repeal section 191.775, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to use of tobacco products in places associated with schools, with penalty provisions.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 191.775, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 191.775, to read as follows:

191.775. **1.** No person shall smoke or otherwise use tobacco or tobacco products in any **of the following places:**

**(1)** Any indoor area of a public elementary or secondary school building or educational facility, excluding institutions of higher education[.];

**(2)** Any [or on] buses used solely to transport students to or from school or to transport students to or from any place for educational purposes; **or**

**(3)** Any grounds or outdoor facility areas of a public elementary or secondary school building or educational facility, excluding institutions of higher education.

**2.** Any school board of any school district may set policy on the permissible uses of tobacco products in any [other] nonclassroom or nonstudent occupant facility **not listed in subsection 1 of this section**[, and on the school grounds or outdoor facility areas as the school board deems proper].

**3.** Any person who violates the provisions of **subsection 1 of this section** shall be guilty of an infraction.
