HB 640 -- SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

SPONSOR: Haefner

This bill specifies that beginning January 1, 2016, the waiver of the work requirement for the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) no longer applies to individuals seeking benefits in this state. Any ongoing savings resulting from a reduction in state expenditures due to modification of SNAP under these provisions, or the temporary assistance for needy families programs occurring on August 28, 2015, must be used to provide child care assistance for single parent households, education assistance, and job training for individuals receiving benefits under those programs.
