

HB 796 -- SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM WORK
REQUIREMENTS

SPONSOR: Haefner

This bill requires the Department of Social Services to allow the current federal waiver of the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) work requirements for able-bodied adults without dependents to expire and prohibits the department from seeking an extension of the waiver. Any ongoing savings resulting from a reduction in state expenditures due to the expiration of the waiver must be used to provide child care assistance for single parent households, education assistance, and job training for individuals receiving benefits under the program.
