HB 1027 -- EMINENT DOMAIN POWER OF UTILITIES

SPONSOR: Hansen

This bill prohibits electric utilities from exercising the power of eminent domain if the project is:

1) Proposed and built outside a regulated regional transmission planning process;

2) Not eligible for regional cost allocation under a transmission tariff of a regional transmission operator or independent system operator; or

3) Constructed entirely with private funds and the users of the line pay for the transmission line.

The bill does not apply to rural electric cooperatives or municipally owned utilities.
