HB 1109 -- SALARY REQUIREMENTS FOR COUNTY SHERIFFS

SPONSOR: McDaniel

This bill specifies that, beginning January 1, 2016, the annual salary of the sheriff in certain counties must not be less than one-half of the annual salary of the county prosecuting attorney established in Section 56.265, RSMO, nor more than three times the amount of the base salary of the lowest salary paid to a full-time deputy sheriff in that county. Currently, this would only apply to Pemiscot and Dunklin counties.
