

HB 1266 -- ALTERNATIVE FUEL DECAL FEE FOR PLUG-IN ELECTRIC HYBRID VEHICLES

SPONSOR: Korman

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Transportation by a vote of 12 to 0.

This bill requires an owner or operator of a plug-in electric hybrid vehicle to pay 50% of the stated annual alternative fuel decal fee.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that all motor fuels should be taxed equally because all cars, regardless of fuel source, damage the road.

Testifying for the bill were Representative Korman and Missouri Petroleum Marketers & Convenience Store Association (MPCA).

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.

OTHERS: Others testifying on the bill say this bill will have a net positive financial impact on Missouri.

Testifying on the bill was Missouri Department of Transportation.
