1 AMEND Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 638, Page 1, In the Title, Line 3, by deleting the
2 word "civics" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "elementary and secondary"; and

4 Further amend said bill, Page 3, Section 170.011, Line 59, by inserting after all of said section and line the
5 following:

7 "170.310. 1. For school year 2017-18 and each school year thereafter, upon graduation from high
8 school, pupils in public schools and charter schools shall have received thirty minutes of cardiopulmonary
9 resuscitation instruction and training in the proper performance of the Heimlich maneuver or other first aid
10 for choking given any time during a pupil's four years of high school.

11 2. Beginning in school year 2017-18, any public school or charter school serving grades nine
12 through twelve [may] shall provide enrolled students instruction in cardiopulmonary resuscitation. Students
13 with disabilities may participate to the extent appropriate as determined by the provisions of the Individuals
14 with Disabilities Education Act or Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act. [Instruction may be embedded in
15 any health education course] Instruction shall be included in the district's existing health or physical
16 education curriculum. Instruction shall be based on a program established by the American Heart
17 Association or the American Red Cross, or through a nationally recognized program based on the most
18 current national evidence-based emergency cardiovascular care guidelines, and psychomotor skills
19 development shall be incorporated into the instruction. For purposes of this section, "psychomotor skills"
20 means the use of hands-on practicing and skills testing to support cognitive learning.

21 [2.] 3. The teacher of the cardiopulmonary resuscitation course or unit shall not be required to be a
22 certified trainer of cardiopulmonary resuscitation if the instruction is not designed to result in certification of
23 students. Instruction that is designed to result in certification being earned shall be required to be taught by
24 an authorized cardiopulmonary instructor. Schools may develop agreements with any local chapter of a
25 voluntary organization of first responders to provide the required hands-on practice and skills testing.

26 [3.] 4. The department of elementary and secondary education may promulgate rules to implement
27 this section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010, that is created under the
28 authority delegated in this section shall become effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of the
29 provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are nonseverable
30 and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to chapter 536 to review, to delay the
31 effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently held unconstitutional, then the grant of
32 rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or adopted after August 28, 2012, shall be invalid and void.";
