- (1) One hundred dollars if the taxpayer has a Missouri adjusted gross income of less than fifteen thousand dollars with no qualifying child or children;
- (2) Six hundred dollars if the taxpayer has a Missouri adjusted gross income of less than forty-five thousand dollars with one qualifying child;
- (3) One thousand dollars if the taxpayer has a Missouri adjusted gross income of more than fifteen thousand dollars but less than forty-five thousand dollars with two qualifying children; or
- (4) One thousand, two hundred dollars if the taxpayer has a Missouri adjusted gross income of more than fifteen thousand dollars but less than fifty-five thousand dollars with three or more qualifying children.
- 6. The director of the department of revenue shall promulgate rules and regulations to administer the provisions of this section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010, that is created under the authority delegated in this section shall become effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are nonseverable, and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to chapter 536 to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or adopted after August 28, 2016, shall be invalid and void."; and
