1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 677, Page 1, In the Title, Lines 2 and 3,
2 by deleting the words "emergency administration of epinephrine by auto-injector" and inserting in
3 lieu thereof the words "health care"; and

5 Further amend said bill and page, Section A, Line 2, by inserting after all of said section and line
6 the following:

8 "191.332. 1. By January 1, 2002, the department of health and senior services shall, subject
9 to appropriations, expand the newborn screening requirements in section 191.331 to include
10 potentially treatable or manageable disorders, which may include but are not limited to cystic
11 fibrosis, galactosemia, biotinidase deficiency, congenital adrenal hyperplasia, maple syrup urine
12 disease (MSUD) and other amino acid disorders, glucose-6-phosphate dehydrogenase deficiency (G-
13 6-PD), MCAD and other fatty acid oxidation disorders, methylmalonic acidemia, propionic
14 acidemia, isovaleric acidemia and glutaric acidemia Type I.

15 2. By January 1, 2017, the department of health and senior services shall, subject to
16 appropriations, expand the newborn screening requirements in section 191.331 to include severe
17 combined immunodeficiency (SCID), also known as bubble boy disease. The department may
18 increase the fee authorized under subsection 6 of section 191.331 to cover any additional costs of
19 the expanded newborn screening requirements under this subsection.

20 3. The department of health and senior services may promulgate rules to implement the
21 provisions of this section. No rule or portion of a rule promulgated pursuant to the authority of this
22 section shall become effective unless it has been promulgated pursuant to chapter 536."; and

24 Further amend said bill, Page 3, Section 196.990, Line 84, by inserting after all of said section and
25 line the following:

27 "Section B. Because immediate action is necessary to ensure the health of newborn babies
28 in Missouri, the enactment of section 191.332 of section A of this act is deemed necessary for the
29 immediate preservation of the public health, welfare, peace, and safety, and is hereby declared to be
30 an emergency act within the meaning of the constitution, and the enactment of section 191.332 of
31 section A of this act shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval."; and

33 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
34 accordingly.
