	320.200 to 320.270;
	(3) "Volunteer firefighter", the same meaning as in section 287.243.
	2. Any association may apply to the state fire marshal for a grant for the purpose of funding
	such association's costs related to workers' compensation insurance premiums for volunteer
	firefighters.
	3. Subject to appropriations, the state fire marshal shall disburse grants to each applying
	volunteer fire protection association according to the following schedule:
	(1) Associations which had zero to five volunteer firefighters receive workers' compensation
	benefits from claims arising out of and in the course of the prevention or control of fire or the
	underwater recovery of drowning victims in the preceding calendar year shall be eligible for two
	thousand dollars in grant money;
	(2) Associations which had six to ten volunteer firefighters receive workers' compensation
	benefits from claims arising out of and in the course of the prevention or control of fire or the
	underwater recovery of drowning victims in the preceding calendar year shall be eligible for one
	thousand five hundred dollars in grant money;
	(3) Associations which had eleven to fifteen volunteer firefighters receive workers'
	compensation benefits from claims arising out of and in the course of the prevention or control of

	for one thousand dollars in grant money;
	(4) Associations which had sixteen to twenty volunteer firefighters receive workers'
