13	2. Any association may apply to the state fire marshal for a grant for the purpose of funding
14	such association's costs related to workers' compensation insurance premiums for volunteer
15	firefighters.
16	3. Subject to appropriations, the state fire marshal shall disburse grants to each applying
17	volunteer fire protection association according to the following schedule:
18	(1) Associations which had zero to five volunteer firefighters receive workers' compensation
19	benefits from claims arising out of and in the course of the prevention or control of fire or the
20	underwater recovery of drowning victims in the preceding calendar year shall be eligible for two
21	thousand dollars in grant money;
22	(2) Associations which had six to ten volunteer firefighters receive workers' compensation
23	benefits from claims arising out of and in the course of the prevention or control of fire or the
24	underwater recovery of drowning victims in the preceding calendar year shall be eligible for one
25	thousand five hundred dollars in grant money;
26	(3) Associations which had eleven to fifteen volunteer firefighters receive workers'
27	compensation benefits from claims arising out of and in the course of the prevention or control of
28	fire or the underwater recovery of drowning victims in the preceding calendar year shall be eligible
29	for one thousand dollars in grant money;
30	(4) Associations which had sixteen to twenty volunteer firefighters receive workers'
31	compensation benefits from claims arising out of and in the course of the prevention or control of
32	fire or the underwater recovery of drowning victims in the preceding calendar year shall be eligible
33	for five hundred dollars in grant money.

*"575.145. 1. It shall be the duty of the operator or driver of any vehicle or any other
conveyance regardless of means of propulsion, or the rider of any animal traveling on the highways
of this state to stop on signal of any law enforcement officer or firefighter and to obey any other
reasonable signal or direction of such law enforcement officer or firefighter given in directing the
movement of traffic on the highways or enforcing any offense or infraction.

The offense of willfully failing or refusing to obey such signals or directions or willfully
 resisting or opposing a law enforcement officer or a firefighter in the proper discharge of his or her
 duties is a class A misdemeanor.
