1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 1583, Page 1, In the Title, Line 3, by  
2 deleting the words "student safety" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "elementary and  
3 secondary education"; and

5 Further amend said bill, Page 4, Section 160.775, Line 111, by inserting after all of said section and  
6 line the following:

8 "170.016. 1. No student shall receive a certificate of graduation from any public high school,  
9 including any charter high school, unless he or she has completed a course on world history.

10 2. Passing a test on world history or otherwise demonstrating proficiency in world history in  
11 lieu of completing a course shall not satisfy the requirement described under subsection 1 of this  
12 section.

13 3. The state board of education shall promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this  
14 section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010, that is created  
15 under the authority delegated in this section shall become effective only if it complies with and is  
16 subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This section and  
17 chapter 536 are nonseverable, and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to  
18 chapter 536 to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently  
19 held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or adopted after  
20 August 28, 2016, shall be invalid and void."; and

22 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
23 accordingly.
