1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 836,  
2 Page 1, Section A, Line 4, by inserting after all of said section and line the following:

3 "167.267. Certified music therapists who have completed the education and clinical training  
4 requirements established by the American Music Therapy Association and passed the Certification  
5 Board for Music Therapists certification examination shall be deemed as certified by the department  
6 of elementary and secondary education for the purposes of providing services identified in an  
7 individualized family service plan in the first steps program under sections 160.900 to 160.925.";

10 Further amend said bill, Page 3, Section 191.1150, Line 82, by inserting after all of said section and  
11 line the following:

12 "195.430. 1. There is hereby established in the state treasury the "Controlled Substance  
13 Abuse Prevention Fund", which shall consist of all fees collected by the department of health and  
14 senior services for the issuance of registrations to manufacture, distribute, or dispense controlled  
15 substances. The state treasurer shall be custodian of the fund. In accordance with sections 30.170  
16 and 30.180, the state treasurer may approve disbursements. The fund shall be a dedicated fund and  
17 moneys in the fund shall be used solely for the operation, regulation, enforcement, and educational  
18 activities of the bureau of narcotics and dangerous drugs. Notwithstanding the provisions of section  
19 33.080 to the contrary, any moneys remaining in the fund at the end of the biennium shall not revert  
20 to the credit of the general revenue fund. The state treasurer shall invest moneys in the fund in the  
21 same manner as other funds are invested. Any interest and moneys earned on such investments  
22 shall be credited to the fund.

23 2. All fees authorized to be charged by the department shall be transmitted to the  
24 department of revenue for deposit in the state treasury for credit to the fund, to be disbursed solely  
25 for the payment of operating expenses of the bureau of narcotics and dangerous drugs to conduct  
26 inspections, enforce controlled substances laws and regulations, provide education to health care  
27 professionals and the public, and to prevent abuse of controlled substances.

28 3. Any moneys appropriated or made available by gift, grant, bequest, contribution, or  
29 otherwise to carry out the purposes of this section shall be paid to and deposited in the controlled  
30 substances abuse prevention fund.

31 195.435. The bureau of narcotics and dangerous drugs shall employ no less than one  
32 investigator for every two thousand five hundred controlled substance registrants."; and
